California Criteria for Cities

- 1. Geographically contiguous
- 2. Undivided neighborhoods and "communities of interest" (Socio-economic geographic areas should be kept together)
- 3. Easily identifiable boundaries
- 4. Compact
 (Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

Prohibited:

"Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party."






